Street Games is a multi-agency initiative that works organisations such as the Council, Police and Lancashire County Council Children & Young People Services who can all refer into they project.		
Recommendation:	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner. 2. That a grant of £2,250 is provided to Tanhouse Community Enterprise conditional they submit their constitution and accounts and meet the fund criteria.
