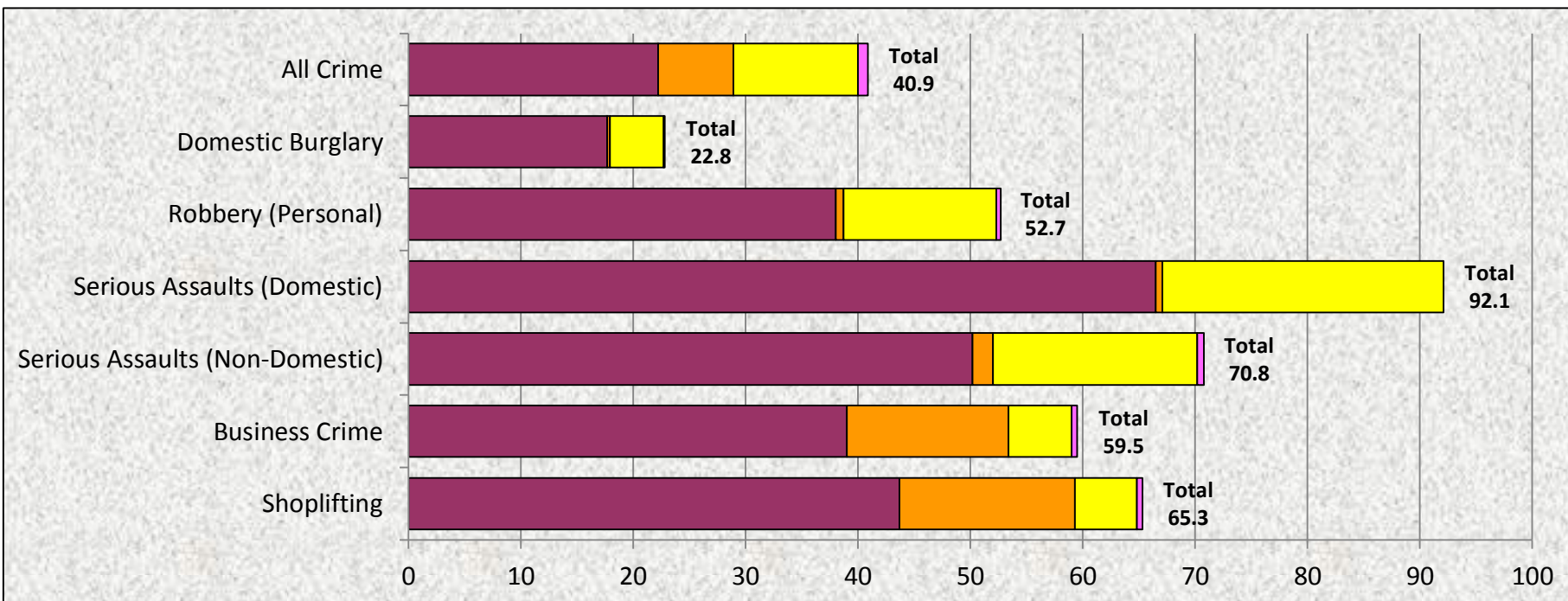

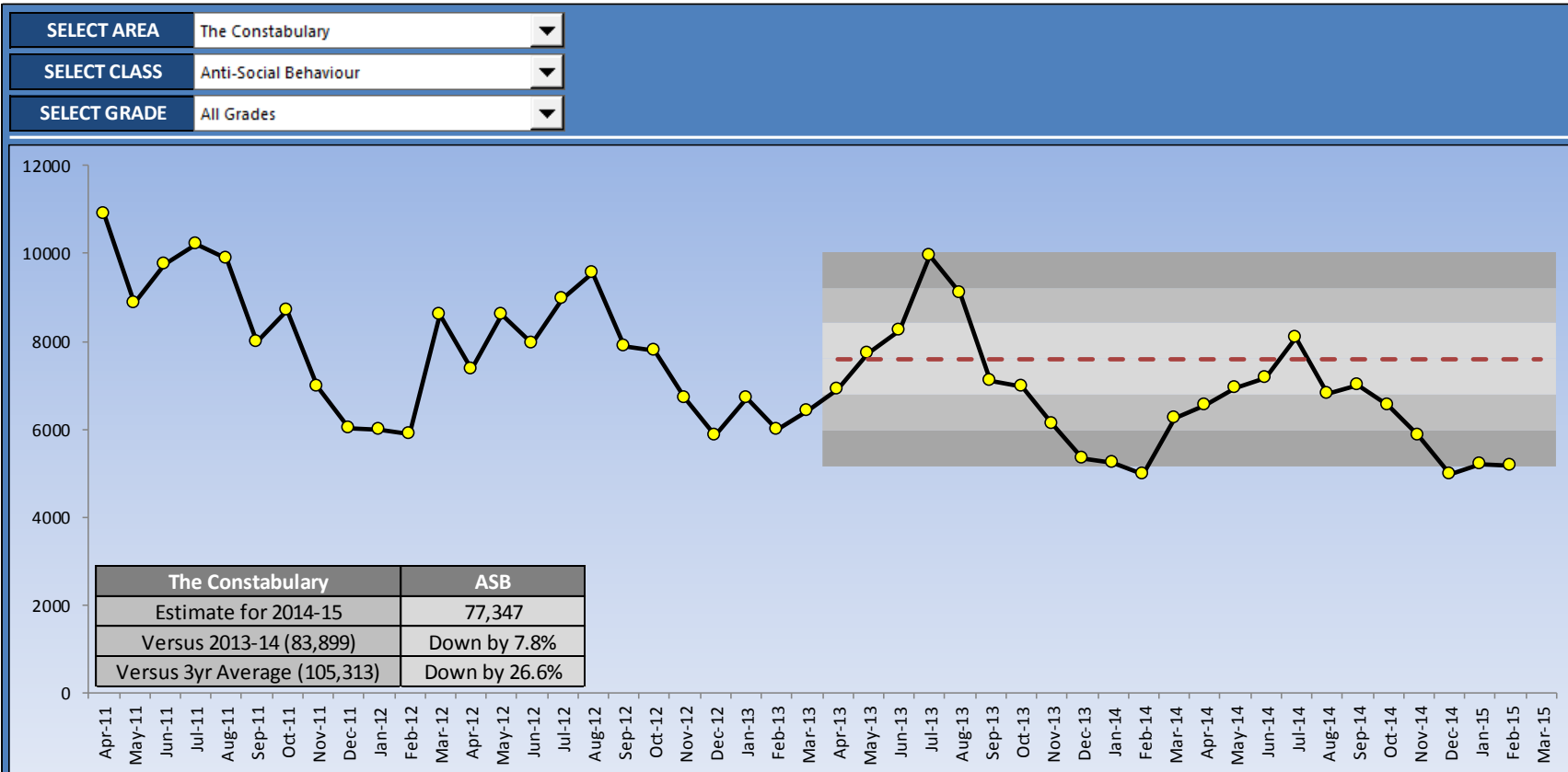

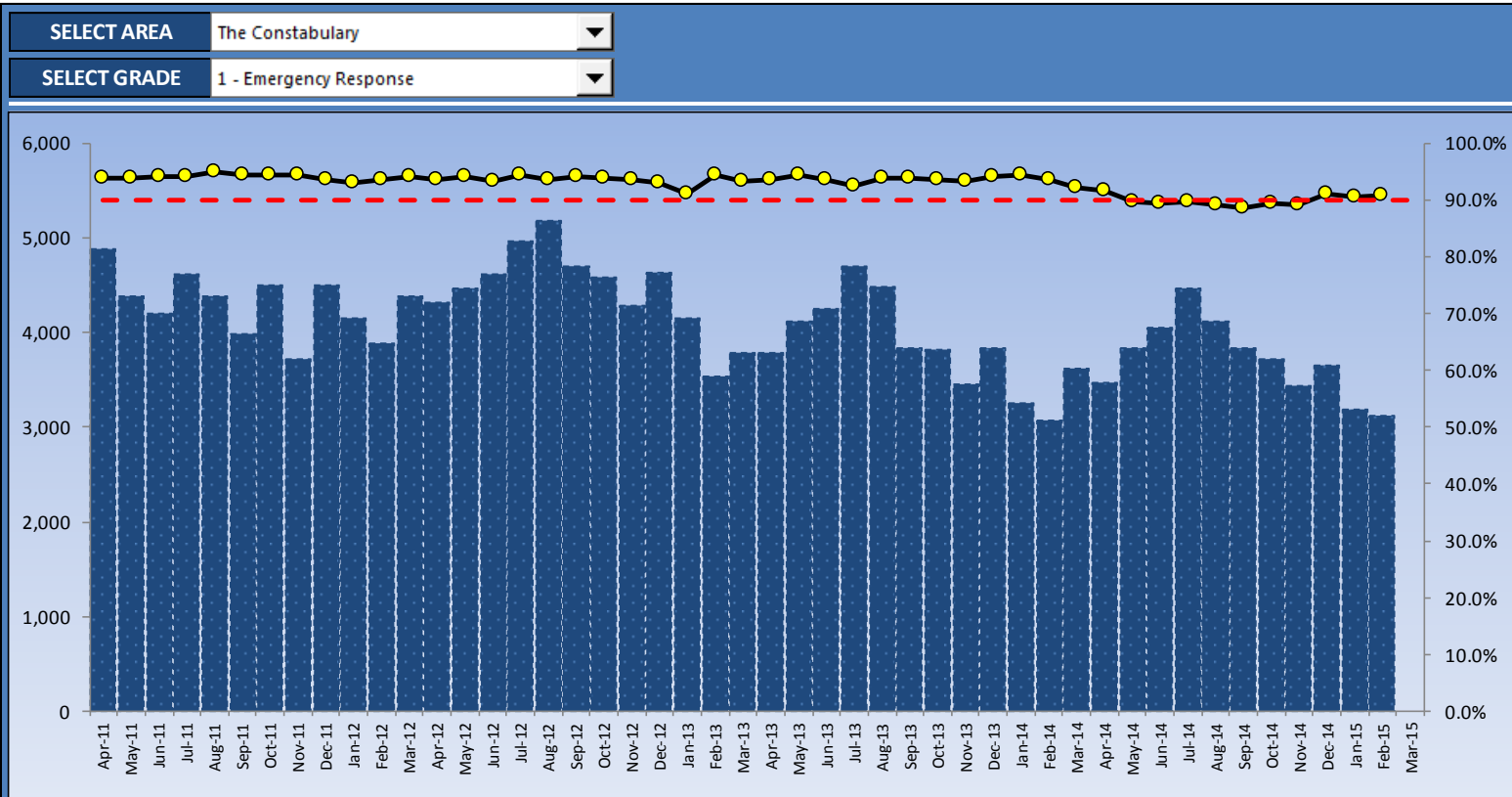

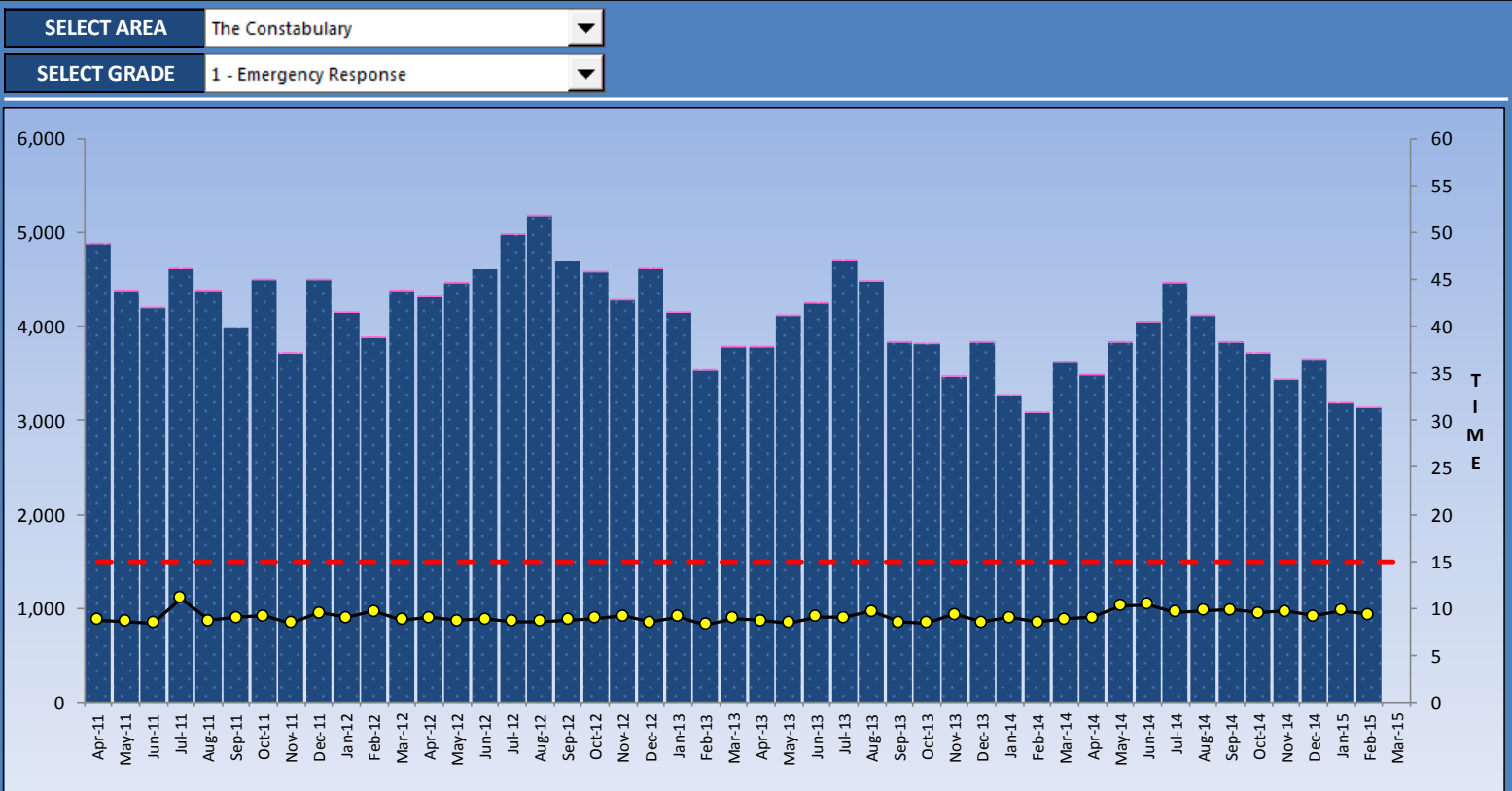

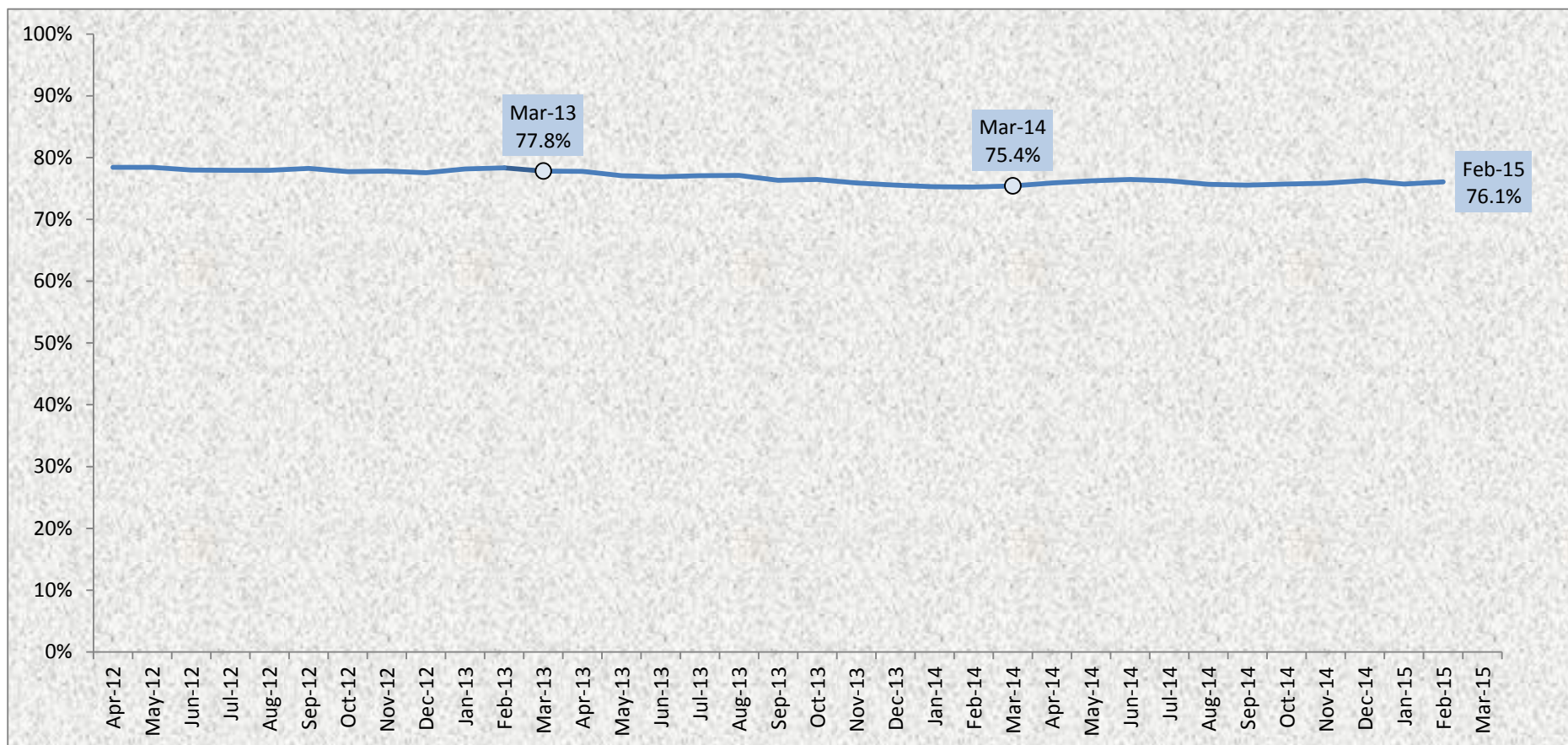
# The Constabulary - User Satisfaction (ASB) Twelve-Month Rolling Result Apr-12 to Dec-14

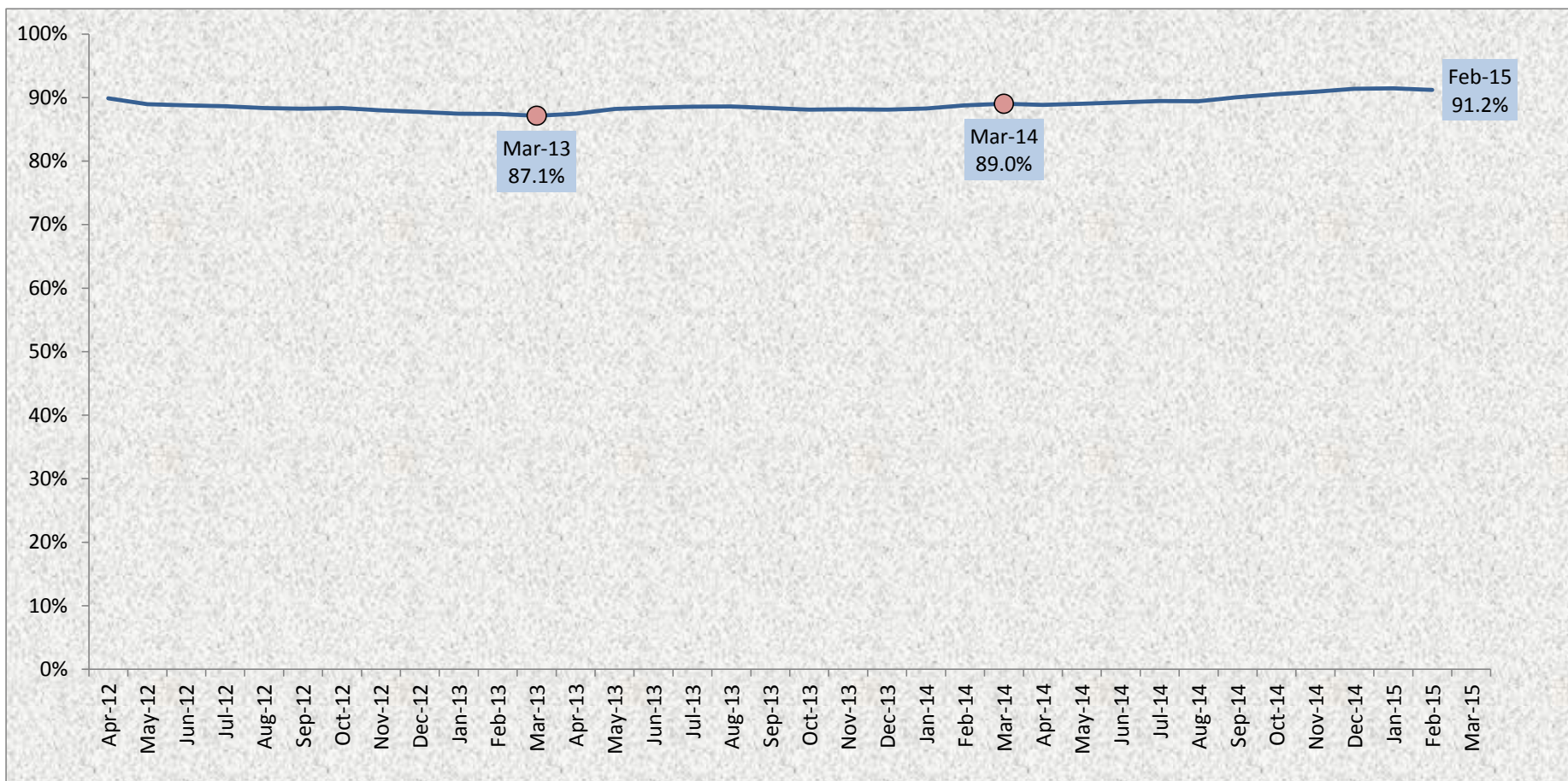
