EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Funding and Commissioning Framework sets out the principles and standards that the Commissioner will apply to the commissioning of services and projects that support the delivery of the policing and community safety priorities as detailed in the Police and Crime Plan.

The Commissioner will seek to ensure that the same principles and standards are applied to any joint or co-commissioning agreements that are made with partners and other organisations.

DEVELOPMENT AND CONSULTATION

This Framework has been developed by the Commissioner's Office and the Commissioner's Team and has taken into account the Commissioning Frameworks of a number of partners including:

- (i) Lancashire Community Safety Strategy Group's Framework
- (ii) APCC Guides for Commissioning
- (iii) Victim's Services Commissioning Framework

Lancashire Constabulary has also been consulted on a draft version of the Framework. The Framework was presented to the Police and Crime Panel on 15 October 2013.
