EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report requests that the Commissioner formally sign the Annual Governance Statement for inclusion in the 2013/14 PCC and Group Statement of Accounts.

The Annual Governance Statement (AGS) forms part of the statutory accounts. Following the change in the governance arrangements due to the election of Police and Crime Commissioners, group accounts are now required. Previously an AGS was produced for both organisations however for the first time separate AGS have been produced; one for the OPCC and one for the Constabulary.

The OPCC has now completed its annual review of governance arrangements and has documented its findings. The OPCC has undertaken a similar process to previous years, which has included completion of comprehensive schedules of evidence and a Certificate of Assurance for each main area of business. A copy of the Commissioner's Annual Governance Statement is attached at Appendix A.

The AGS has been considered and accepted by the Joint Audit Committee on 16 June 2014.
