<b>1. NAME:</b>	IQRA EDUCATION TRUST		
<b>AREA:</b>	Preston	<b>PRIORITY:</b>	Vulnerable People
<b>AMOUNT REQUESTED:</b>	£500	<b>Match Funds:</b>	None
<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	Not In My Name £500		
<b>Summary:</b>	The project is to provide an interactive session to work with Muslim children and young people to discuss issues related to radicalisation and the ISIS situation in Iraq and Syria. The project will emphasise the importance of living together as one community and value the differences that exist within the community in a positive way.		
<b>Comments:</b>	This initiative is supported by the Counter Terrorism unit at the Constabulary and the proposed speakers are known and approved.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner 2. That a grant of <b>£500</b> is provided to cover the cost of running this programme.		

<b>2. NAME:</b>	VOLUNTEER BURNLEY		
<b>AREA:</b>	Burnley	<b>PRIORITY:</b>	ASB & Criminal Damage
<b>AMOUNT REQUESTED:</b>	£1,500.00	<b>Match Funds:</b>	In Kind from Burnley Leisure Social Prescribing Space Bus
<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	Active Streets £2,580.00		
<b>Summary:</b>	The Active Streets programme will provide a range of diversionary activities for young people from areas within the borough identified as ASB and arson hot spots. The project will work with the Space Bus and use the new all-weather pitch. The project aims to engage between 50 and 100 young people each week.		

<b>Comments:</b>	This project focuses on engaging with young people from some of the more deprived wards in the Burnley area and will contribute to reductions in ASB and arson.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner 2. That a grant of <b>£1500</b> is provided to towards cost of the project – representing 58% of the cost of this project.		

<b>3. NAME:</b>	LONGRIDGE YOUTH GYM		
<b>AREA:</b>	Longridge, Ribble Valley	<b>PRIORITY:</b>	ASB & Criminal Damage
<b>AMOUNT REQUESTED:</b>	£1,325.00	<b>Match Funds:</b>	Lancashire Sport Partnership – Sportivate Longridge Council
<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	Youth Gym & Urban Sports £3,450.00		
<b>Summary:</b>	The project provides a range of sport activities on a Friday evening for young people identified by the Police as at risk of being involved in ASB or criminal damage.		
<b>Comments:</b>	The Gym has secured funding from Sportivate and are looking for further funding to extend the programme from 32 sessions to 50 sessions and to increase the number of young people able to attend.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner 2. That a grant of <b>£1,325.00</b> is provided to towards cost of the project – representing 38% of the cost of the project.		

<b>4. NAME:</b>	STAR CENTRE		
<b>AREA:</b>	Rossendale	<b>PRIORITY:</b>	Vulnerable People Domestic Abuse
<b>AMOUNT REQUESTED:</b>	£2,500	<b>Match Funds:</b>	Applied to Local Members Fund (LCC) for £2500
<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	Sanctuary and Safety Project £5,000.00		
<b>Summary:</b>	The project provides security checks and items for victims of domestic abuse to enable them to remain within their own homes. Rossendale does not have any refuge provision so this service is vital to ensuring that victims can safely remain in the area if they wish. This can positively contribute to their ability to recover and enables families to be kept together reducing the impact of domestic abuse on children.		
<b>Comments:</b>	As there is a lack of refuge provision in the area this service is an essential addition to the services and facilities that the Star Centre already provides.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner 2. That a grant of <b>£2500</b> is provided to towards cost of the project.		

<b>5. NAME:</b>	THE LOVE AND ETIQUETTE FOUNDATION		
<b>AREA:</b>	Preston & Pan-Lancashire	<b>PRIORITY:</b>	Reducing Re-offending
<b>AMOUNT REQUESTED:</b>	£1,600.00	<b>Match Funds:</b>	Probation/CRC £5000 In Kind resources - £1000
<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	CUBIZM £7,600		
<b>Summary:</b>	The project uses arts and music to engage and educate offenders to contribute to their reduction in re-offending through helping them to connect with the local community. The project uses a mentoring approach to working with offenders. The project is located in the centre of Preston at various venues and involves young and adult offenders from across Lancashire.		

<b>Comments:</b>	This project is fully supported and part funded by Probation/CRC and is seen by them as an effective tool to reduce re-offending. The use of mentors is in line with the Commissioner's approach to supporting projects that use peer support models alongside input from professionals.
<b>Recommendation:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner</li><li>2. That a grant of <b>£1,600</b> is provided to towards the cost of the project – representing 21% of the cost of the project.</li></ol>

<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is <b>NOT</b> supported by the Commissioner 2. That it is noted that the overall project cost is in excess of £10,000.
