## **1 Issue for Consideration**

## **3 Background**

3.1 The Commissioner approved a revised scheme for the provision of cars to senior officers of the Office of the PCC and of the Constabulary in November 2013. Unfortunately the Office of the PCC has omitted to bring this decision to the Audit Committee for review and the committee is therefore asked to consider this scheme in retrospect.

3.2 It should be noted that the scheme includes the provision of a car from the Constabulary fleet for the use of the PCC.
