PROCEDURE FOR THE MEETING OF POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER TO CONSIDER (i)WHETHER AN APPLICATION TO THE HOME OFFICE FOR A CERTIFICATE OF FORFEITURE IS WARRANTED; OR (ii)TO DETERMINE WHETHER A POLICE PENSION SHOULD BE FORFEITED AND THE EXTENT OF FORFEITURE (paragraphs 7 and 8)

- 1. The Chairperson will open the meeting introducing all present (and the Director will briefly outline the procedure to be followed at the meeting).
- 2. The officer / former officer or their representative will make oral representations based upon their written representations.
- 3. The Chief Constable will then respond to those representations if necessary.
- 4. The Police and Crime Commissioner will then clarify any outstanding issues.
- 5. The officer / former officer and their representative and the Chief Constable will then leave the meeting.
- 6. The Police and Crime Commissioner will make his or her decision in private with advice from the Director and legal advisers, as appropriate.
- 7. The Director will convey the decision to the officer/former officer and/or legal representative in writing, within 14 days of the meeting.
