



COMMUNITY ACTION FUND DECISION 2018/59 NOTE

Decision 2018/59 was submitted to the Police and Crime Commissioner for consideration, recommending the allocation of £15,338.87 from the Community Action Fund to the seven projects outlined in Decision 2018/59 Appendix A.




The Commissioner approved the allocation of funding for:

1. FACE – Family and Community Enterprise
2. Friends of Eastpines Park
3. Skerton Community Centre
4. Lancashire Equalities Organisation
5. Preston Pirates BMX Club
6. Rhyddings Park Neighbourhood Watch

Totalling £13,388.87 but rejected Rishton Festival Association as the project does not clearly meet the Commissioner's priorities outlined in the Police and Crime Plan.

Financial Implications

The approved applications bring the total spend for the Community Action Fund in 2018/19 to £111,625.16 which will be contained within the overall PCC revenue budget.
