Project Name & Cost	Communities R Us £2,000		
Summary:	Communities R Us work with those who have multiple and complex needs, most who are often in contact with criminal justice agencies having recently been released from prison and / or have a criminal record. Communities R Us will deliver a range of training courses with the aim to increase employability. Courses will include CV writing / job application help sessions, first aid and health and safety.		
Comments:	Communities R Us receive referrals from a wide variety of sources such as charities, housing associations and substance misuse services. Communities R Us aim to work with and support up to 150 people annually.

2. NAME:	Dig In North West		
AREA:	Preston	PRIORITY:	Tackling crime and reoffending & Developing safe and confident communities.
AMOUNT REQUESTED:	£2,320	Match Funds:	Organisations own resources.
Project Name & Cost	Open Doors £5,720		
Summary:	Dig In North West work with and support military veterans and those serving in the armed forces and emergency services who have faced trauma based mental ill health linked to their service. Dig In North West has recently been targeted to anti-social behaviour and therefore wish to run a pilot project where they open their doors to members of the local community providing a variety of workshops and activities with the aim to make local people aware of the work they undertake.		
Comments:	Dig In North West work with the local policing team and together aim to target certain youngsters in the area.		
Recommendation:	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner. 2. That a grant of £2,320 is provided to Dig In North West.
