## **Executive Summary**

The Commissioner has established a Community Action Fund and has allocated £150,000 to the Community Action Fund for 2019-20.

Applications are invited from voluntary, community and faith (VCF) sector constituted organisations. The Fund is administered by LANPAC on behalf of the Commissioner.

LANPAC has received 17 applications in June 2019 which have been reviewed in line with the terms and conditions and criteria of the Fund as follows:

The Commissioner is recommended to approve the level of funding for the Applications as outlined in Appendix A.

The total amount of funding recommended is £25,413.00

The 2019-20 budget for the Community Action Fund is £150,000.00 of which £0.00 has already been approved and awarded to other projects and schemes. The £25,413.00 funding for these applications will be met from the remaining £150,000.00 leaving an unspent balance in the Fund of £124,587.00
