Executive Summary

- The Commissioner's revenue budget for 2019-20 includes an allocation of £200,000 for Reducing Reoffending Funding.
- The Commissioner launched a grant opportunity in June 2019 for organisations who provide support to offenders. Organisations could apply for up to £25,000 for projects and initiatives which meet at least one of the key aims of the reducing reoffending strategy as well as the Police and Crime Commissioners priorities.
- The Reducing Reoffending fund closed on Monday 8th July 2019 with 18 organisations submitting applications for funding.
- This Decision seeks to confirm the allocation of £197,562.00 from the Reducing Reoffending Fund to the projects and initiatives outlined in Appendix A.

The Commissioner is recommended to approve the proposed use of the Reducing Reoffending Fund as outlined in Appendix A.


