TITLE: REDUCING REOFFENDING FUNDING

Executive Summary

The Commissioner's revenue budget for 2018-19 includes an allocation of £200,000 for Reducing Reoffending Funding. Not all of this money was allocated.

A further grant opportunity was therefore launched in February 2019 and £20,000 awarded to each of the four local Reducing Reoffending Boards (North, East, South and West). Organisations could make application for bids of up to £20,000 for projects and initiatives which met at least one of the key aims of the reducing reoffending strategy as well as the Police and Crime Commissioners priorities. Ideally applications should consider a trauma informed approach.

The Reducing Reoffending fund closed on Monday 25 February 2019 with 21 Applications being received.

This Decision seeks to confirm the allocation of £103,137 from the Reducing Reoffending Fund to the projects and initiatives outlined in Appendix A.

Recommendations

The Commissioner is recommended to approve the proposed use of the Reducing Reoffending Fund as outlined in Appendix A.
