<b>Summary:</b>	Fylde Coast Youth Theatre Company will run a 3 month project to 25 young people (aged 11-17). Young people will write, direct, act, dance and sing a performance which explores the topic of teenage mental health, bereavement, divorce and anger issues.		
<b>Comments:</b>	Lancashire Mind will attend sessions to deliver wellbeing talks and be on hand to support and talk through any issues that may arise.

<b>Summary:</b>	Opportunity Sports Foundation wish to run a one year project that will work with vulnerable young people, in particular the homeless. The will offer sports sessions as well as literacy & numeracy courses, job searching CV writing and interview skills.		
<b>Comments:</b>	Opportunity Sports Foundation will work in partnership with Nightsafe & The Foyer to target and support those most vulnerable and at the risk of offending.

<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	New Beginning's 2 £2,450		
<b>Summary:</b>	West Lancs Ark will work with ex-offenders who have been released from prison, the homeless and recovering substance misusers offering guidance, advice and support.		
<b>Comments:</b>	West Lancs Ark receive great feedback for the work they do and in a previous project they helped seven vulnerable people find employment, five people accommodation and those involved with the project did not reoffend.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner. 2. That a grant of <b>£2,450</b> is provided to West Lancs Ark.

<b>AMOUNT REQUESTED:</b>	£2,500	<b>Match Funds:</b>	Organisations own resources
<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	Upgrade of goals / pitches £3,000		
<b>Summary:</b>	The community-based venue would like funding to upgrade two goals posts and a football pitch.		
<b>Comments:</b>	The facility attracts up to 160 young people and adults per week and opens up late into the evening to provide a safe environment for young people at the risk of offending.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner. 2. That a grant of <b>£2,500</b> is provided to Heysham Mossgate Community & Sports Facilities.
