Executive Summary:

1. The Commissioner's revenue budget for 2015-16 includes an allocation of £2.288M for Community Safety and Partnership Funding.
2. In line with the approach agreed by the Commissioner the Victims, Partnerships & Commissioning Manager has held discussions with a number of partners regarding a range of proposed services and programmes which support the Commissioner's aims and priorities.
3. This Decision seeks to confirm the allocation of £1,756,933.00 from the Community Safety and Partnership Fund to the projects, programmes and services detailed in Appendix B.
4. If this Decision is confirmed, there will be a balance of £531,067.00 remaining in the Community Safety and Partnership Fund for allocation against additional community safety activity.

Recommendation:

The Commissioner is recommended to approve the proposed use of the Community Safety and Partnership Fund as outlined in Appendix A and to note the implications in respect of funding that could be available for additional future community safety activity.
