### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

1. The Commissioner has approved the budget for 2014 – 15 (Decision 2013/41) which includes an allocation of £1.974M for Community Safety and Partnership Funding.
2. In line with the approach agreed by the Commissioner the Commissioning and Partnerships Manager has held discussions with a number of partners regarding a range of proposed services and programmes which support the Commissioner's aims and priorities.
3. This Decision seeks to confirm the allocation of £154,826.00 from the following funding streams:

Community Safety Fund	£131,354.00
MoJ Victims Fund 2013	£ 5,000.00
MoJ Victims Fund 2014	£ 18,472.00

Funding will be allocated to the projects and programmes detailed in Appendix A.
4. If this Decision is confirmed, there will be a balance of £484,685 remaining in the Community Safety & Partnership Fund for allocation against additional community safety activity.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

The Commissioner is recommended to approve the proposed use of the Community Safety and Partnership Fund and the MoJ Victims Funds as outlined in Appendix A and to note the implications in respect of funding that could be available for additional future community safety activity.
