Executive Summary

1. In 2013/14 the Police and Crime Commissioner provided each of the Constabulary's nine cadet units a start-up grant of £2,000 – a total of £18k.
2. Since then, the units have become largely self-funding, through fundraising and donations.
3. A request has now been received from the Volunteer Police Cadets for £20k of funding which would contribute toward the central costs of running the organisation, including transport for cadets to events, attestation nights and training for volunteers.

2. That the money be taken from POCA funding.
