Issue for consideration

The provision of a £1000 contribution to the Royal Humane Society to enable continued recognition of actions of bravery and valour by police officers and the awarding of the Police Medal to recognise outstanding bravery by a Police Officer. The constabulary has a long standing relationship with the RHS and has contributed similar amounts annually.

Governance Framework Section Reference

Under paragraph 8.30 of the ISOG, the Chief Constable's CFO may approve grants to voluntary or community organisations, subject to the award complying with the PCC's commissioning framework. The PCC has been consulted and agrees that this award is in line with his priorities for funding. Consultation took place by means of an email to the PCC Chief Executive and subsequent discussion with PCC Chief executive on 24th July 2013

Costs

The cost is £1000 and will be met from the Police Property Act.

Risks

No risks in approving the award. Reputational risk if the award is not approved.

Consequences

Recognition that the PCC/Chief Constable recognises the value of supporting activities recognising bravery and valour.

Consultation

Consultation with Finance and the PCC, who are supportive.
