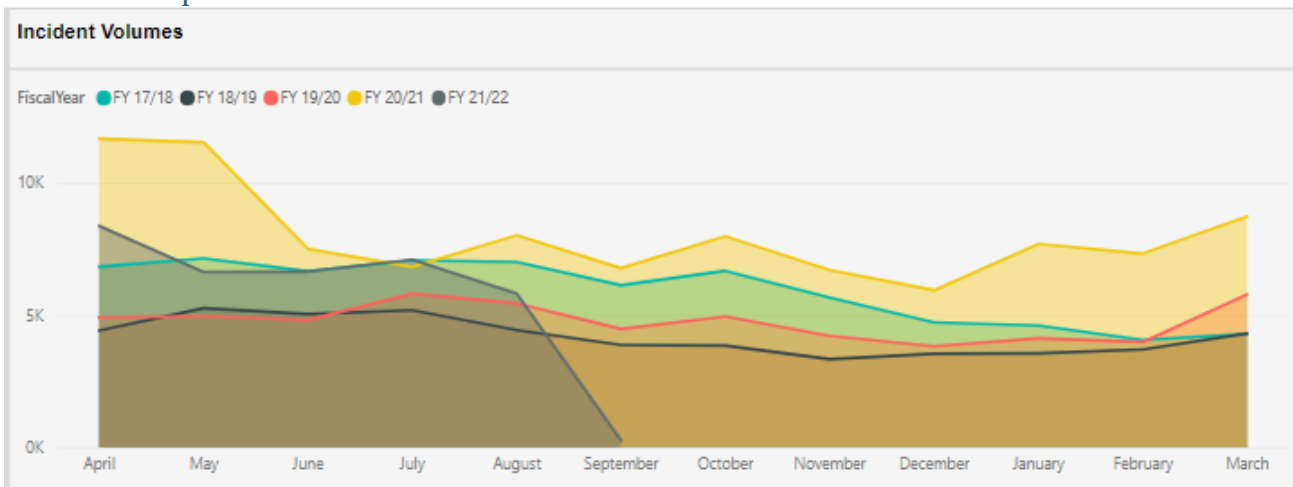

### Incidents reported



- The volume of anti-social behaviour (ASB) incidents since Apr 21 is 6-8,000 reports a month, which is lower than the previous year.
- Neighbourhood Policing Team (NPT) officers responded to 4,504 incidents in the last 3 months (Jun-Aug 21).

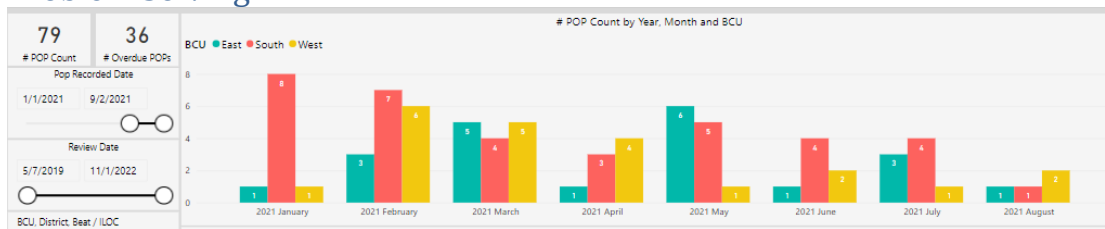

- Jan-Aug 2021 there were 58,277 reports of ASB to the Constabulary, and 30,515 deployments.

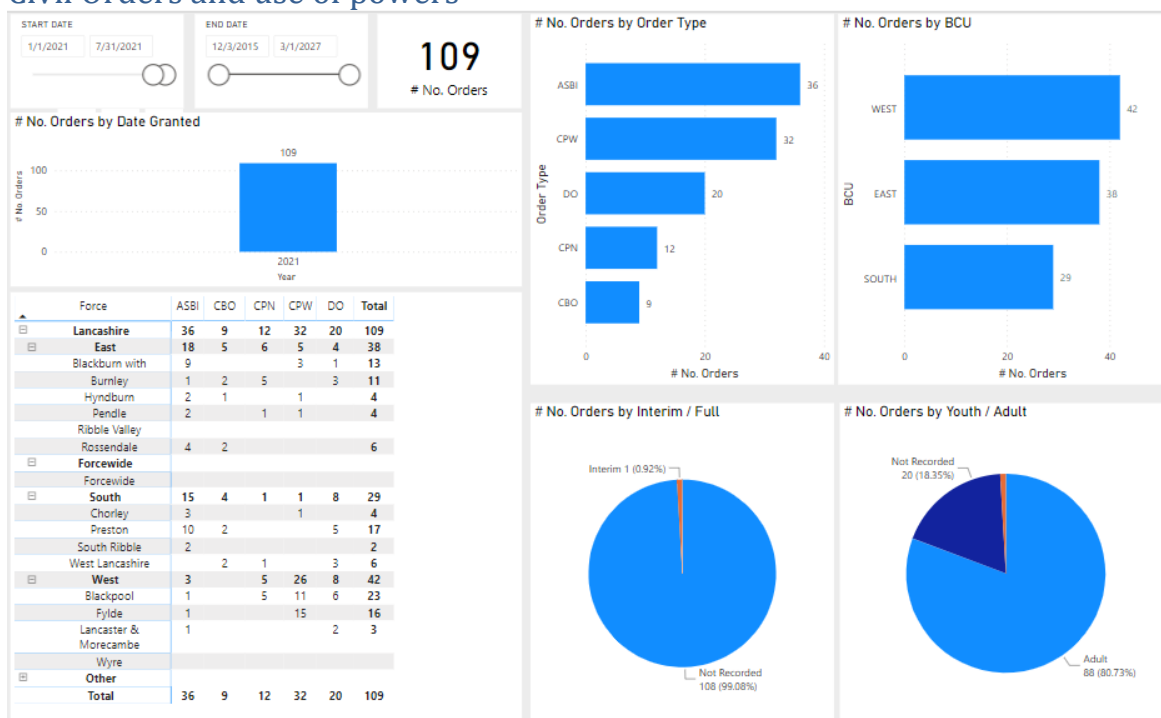
- NPT respond to approximately 50% of ASB incidents attended, response officers 38%, COVID tasked patrols 14%. Many of the non-deployed incidents are also emailed to NPT, which may result in recontact not recorded within the above figures.

### Problem Solving



- There are 79 Problem Solving plans submitted Jan21 to date which specifically relate to ASB. This compares to 34 for the same period last year.

### Civil Orders and use of powers



- For Jan-21 to Jul-21, there are 109 recorded uses of Civil Orders or powers. This compares to 87 in the same period in 2020, and 12 in 2019.
- 36 Anti-Social Behaviour Injunctions, 32 Community Protection warnings, 20 Dispersal Orders, 12 Community Protection Notices & 9 Criminal Behaviour Orders.
- The Neighbourhood Development Team and Blackpool NPT have provided training inputs on the use of Civil Orders to all NPTs across the county this year. We have had discussions with both HQ Legal and the Civil Orders Teams to try and improve the advice and support available to officers seeking civil orders.

### General comments

- ASB remains the **No.1 issue** reported by residents under Lancashire Talking. Officers are responding locally to hotspot locations with targeted action and problem solving and updating the community. 441 Alerts (399,000 messages) sent to *In The Know* subscribers in August, many relate to updates from the local NPT on proactive activity to tackle ASB.
- The force contributed to the national **ASB Awareness Week** this summer, publicising local proactive activity via Lancashire Talking and social media.
- Supt Richard Robertshaw, strategic lead for ASB, has led the development of a force wide approach to **tackling motorcycle nuisance**. He chairs a force ASB group with designated Chief Inspector leads in each BCU. He also represents the force on the National ASB Working Group.
- The HQ Development Team are organising a 1-day workshop for BCU staff on taking a **problem solving approach to tackling ASB**, which will be facilitated by Professor Stuart Kirby.
