AMOUNT REQUESTED:	£2,512
SUMMARY:	Leyland NPT will work with three schools and engage young people to become mini ambassadors. Their focus is to raise awareness of dangerous parking / driving. The project aims to engage parents and the community on local concerns in a different way, through the mini ambassadors.
RECOMMENDATION:	The Commissioner is recommended to approve the allocation of £2,512 for the No Need for Speed/Mini PCSO's Project.

PROJECT NAME COST	Mobile Command Unit – upgrade to existing vehicle
AREA:	East and South Divisions
PROJECT DURATION:	Ongoing
AMOUNT REQUESTED:	£14,865.35
SUMMARY:	Funding will support the upgrades of the Mobile Command Units for East and South Division. Large digital screens will be mounted to the side of the vehicle to display key campaign messages for example awareness of VAWG within the night-time economy. The screens will also be able to share operational key messages.
RECOMMENDATION:	The Commissioner has previously awarded £7,946 towards the upgrade of the West Mobile Command Unit Project (Decision 2022-18). The Commissioner is recommended to approve the additional allocation of £14,865.35 towards the upgrade of the East and South Mobile Command Unit.
