Executive Summary

The Commissioner has provided funding for the provision of grants to enable activity that supports the delivery of his Police and Crime Plan.

The Safer Lancashire Neighbourhoods Fund includes the Police Innovation Fund which provides grants to police staff and officers for innovative crime reduction initiatives that will make policing more efficient and effective and have a positive impact on the community.
