Q1) In developing my budget proposals, I want to see Lancashire Constabulary receive more funding to deliver investments in cutting and preventing crime, protecting the vulnerable and supporting victims across the county. Do you agree?

Yes - 85%

No - 7%

Maybe - 8%

Q2) The Council Tax precept for policing is approximately 11% of your annual Council Tax bill. The Band D Council Tax for policing in Lancashire for 2023/2024 is £251.45. How much more would you pay to maintain growth and investment in policing in Lancashire?

Up to £10 a year (up to 19p a week) – 23.62%

Up to £20 a year (up to 38p a week) – 21.52%

More than £20 a year (more than 38p a week) – 18.71%

I would not be willing to pay any more – 36.15%
