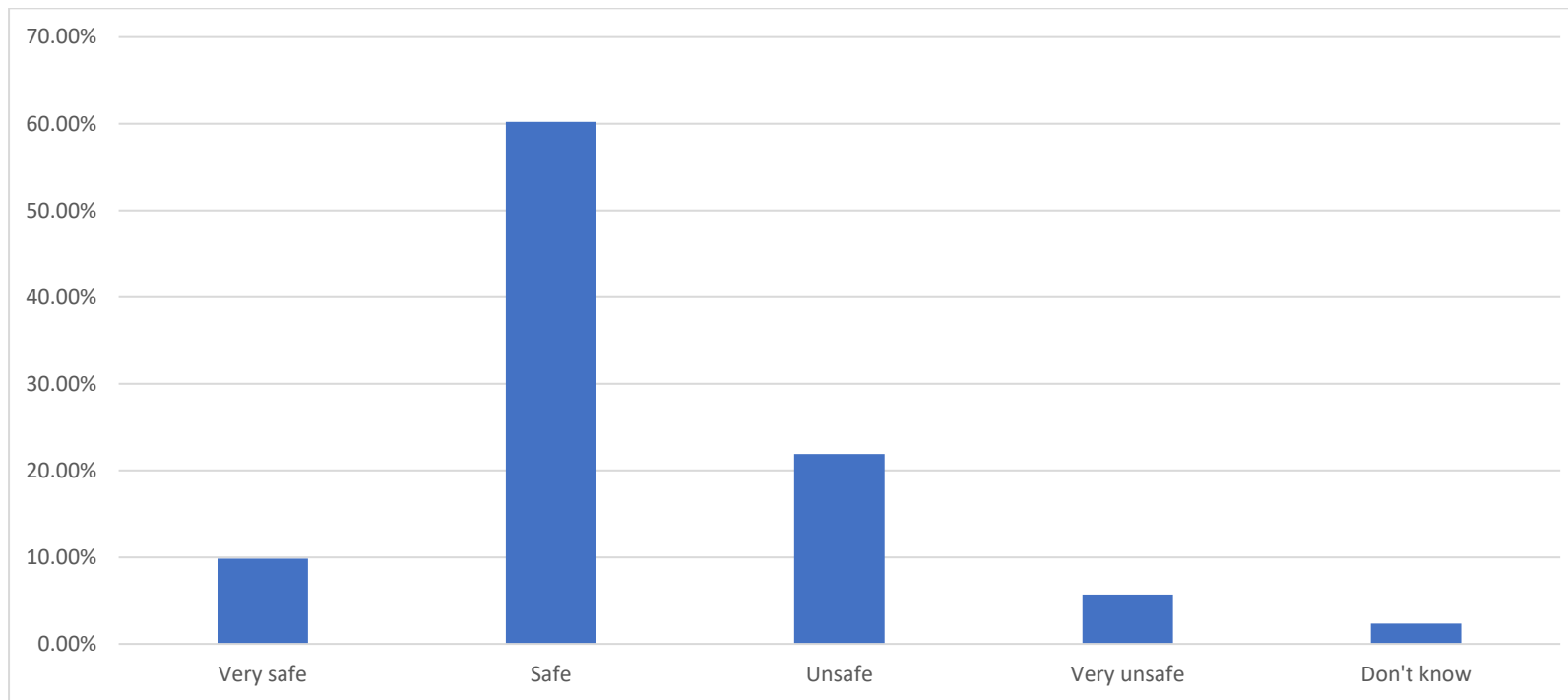


Lancashire Police and Crime Commissioner - Police and Crime Plan Survey 2024

- The Office of the Lancashire Police and Crime Commissioner conducted a county-wide survey of residents 18+ across Lancashire (12 districts, plus the 2 unitary authorities of Blackpool and Blackburn with Darwen).
- **6,156** Lancashire residents responded either online or through a paper copy supplied upon request between 8th July and 30th September.

How safe do you feel where you live?

70.04% of survey respondents feel **safe** or **very safe** where they live.



In your view, what crime type or other policing issues does your local area have the biggest problem with?



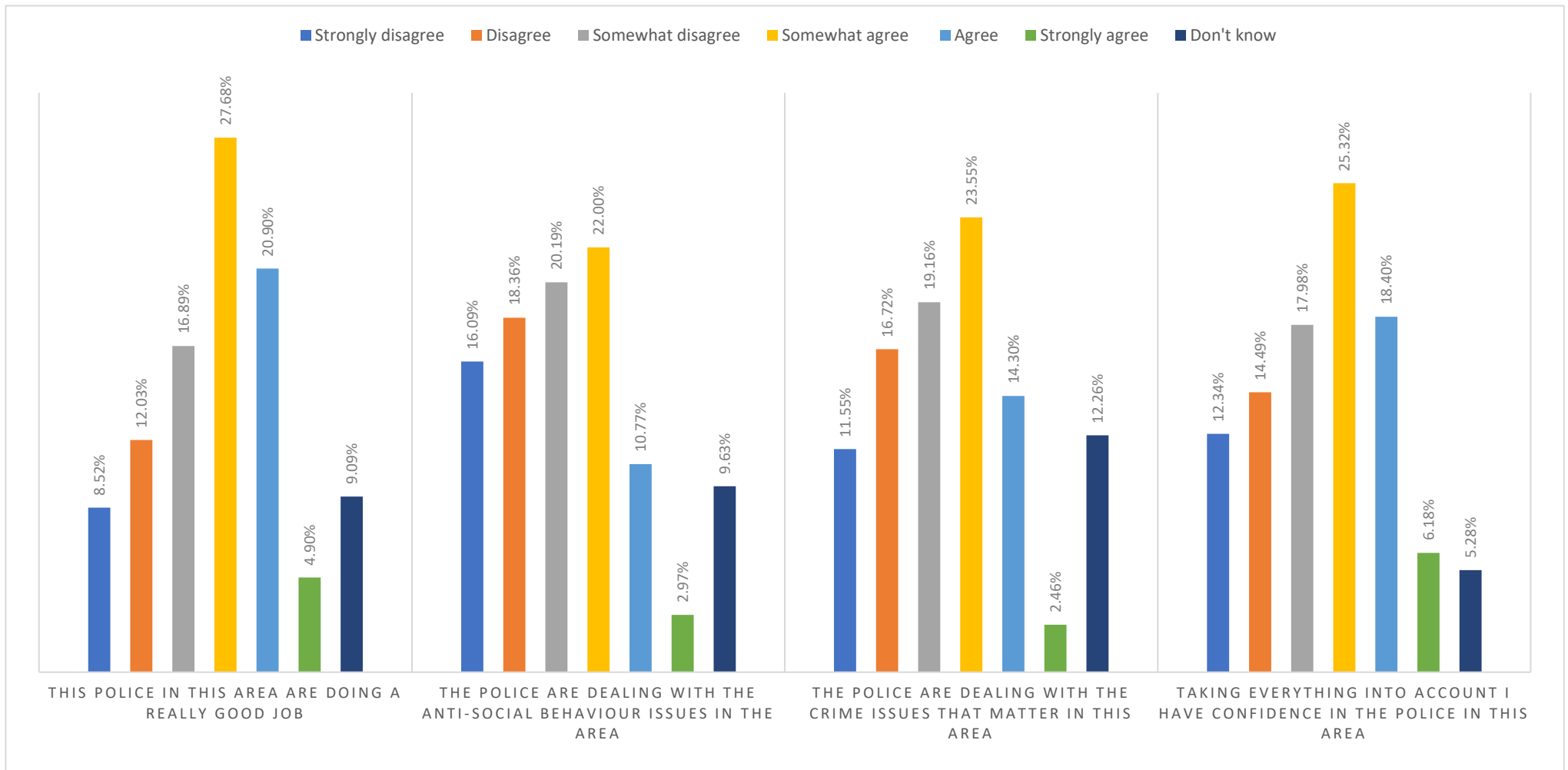
To what extent do you agree with the following statements?

53.48% strongly agree, agree, or somewhat agree the police in this area are doing a really good job.

35.74% strongly agree, agree, or somewhat agree the police are dealing with the anti-social behaviour issues in the area.

40.31% strongly agree, agree, or somewhat agree the police are dealing with the crime issues that matter in this area.

49.9% strongly agree, agree, or somewhat agree taking everything into account I have confidence in the police in the area.



Police and Crime Plan Priorities - Please share your views on each area of focus.

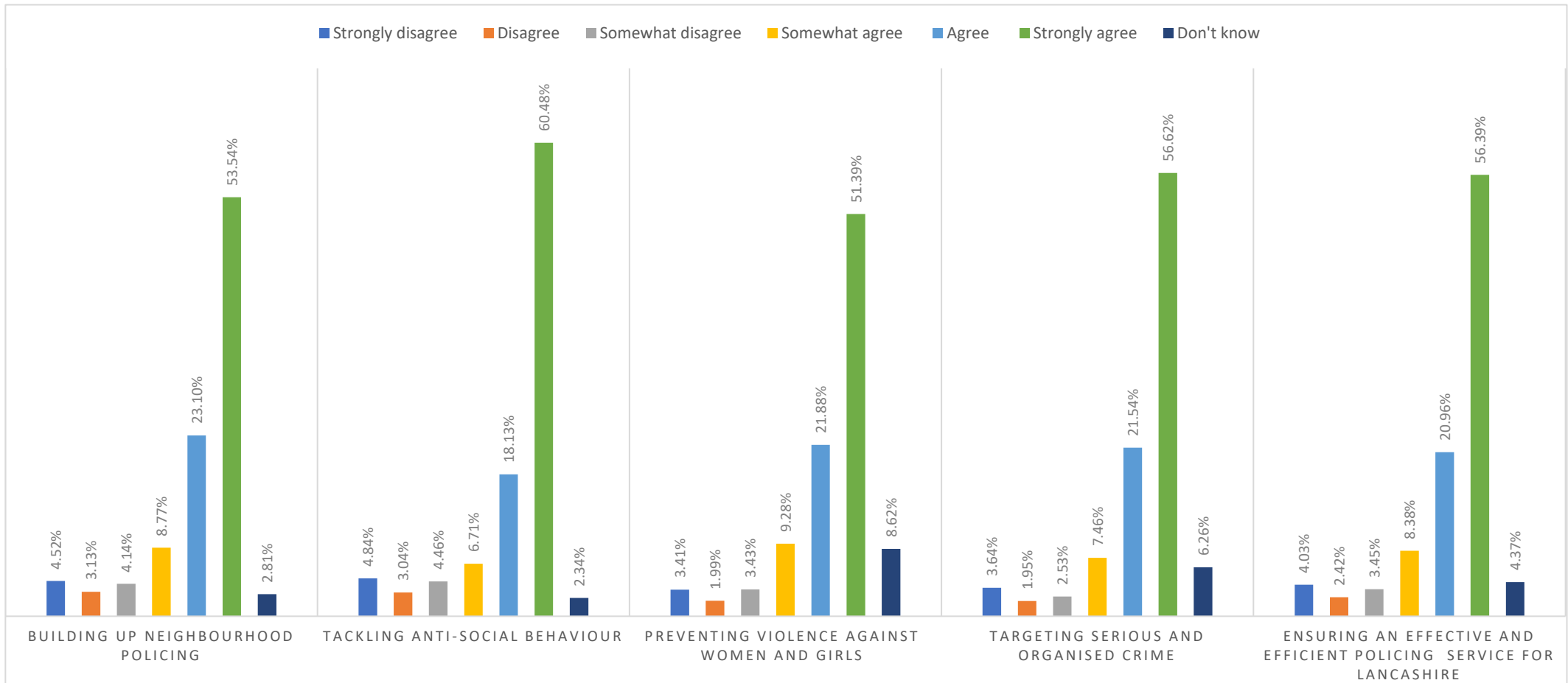
85.41% strongly agree, somewhat agree, or agree on building up neighbourhood policing as an area of focus.

85.32% strongly agree, somewhat agree, or agree on tackling anti-social behaviour as an area of focus.

82.55% strongly agree, somewhat agree, or agree on preventing violence against women and girls as an area of focus.

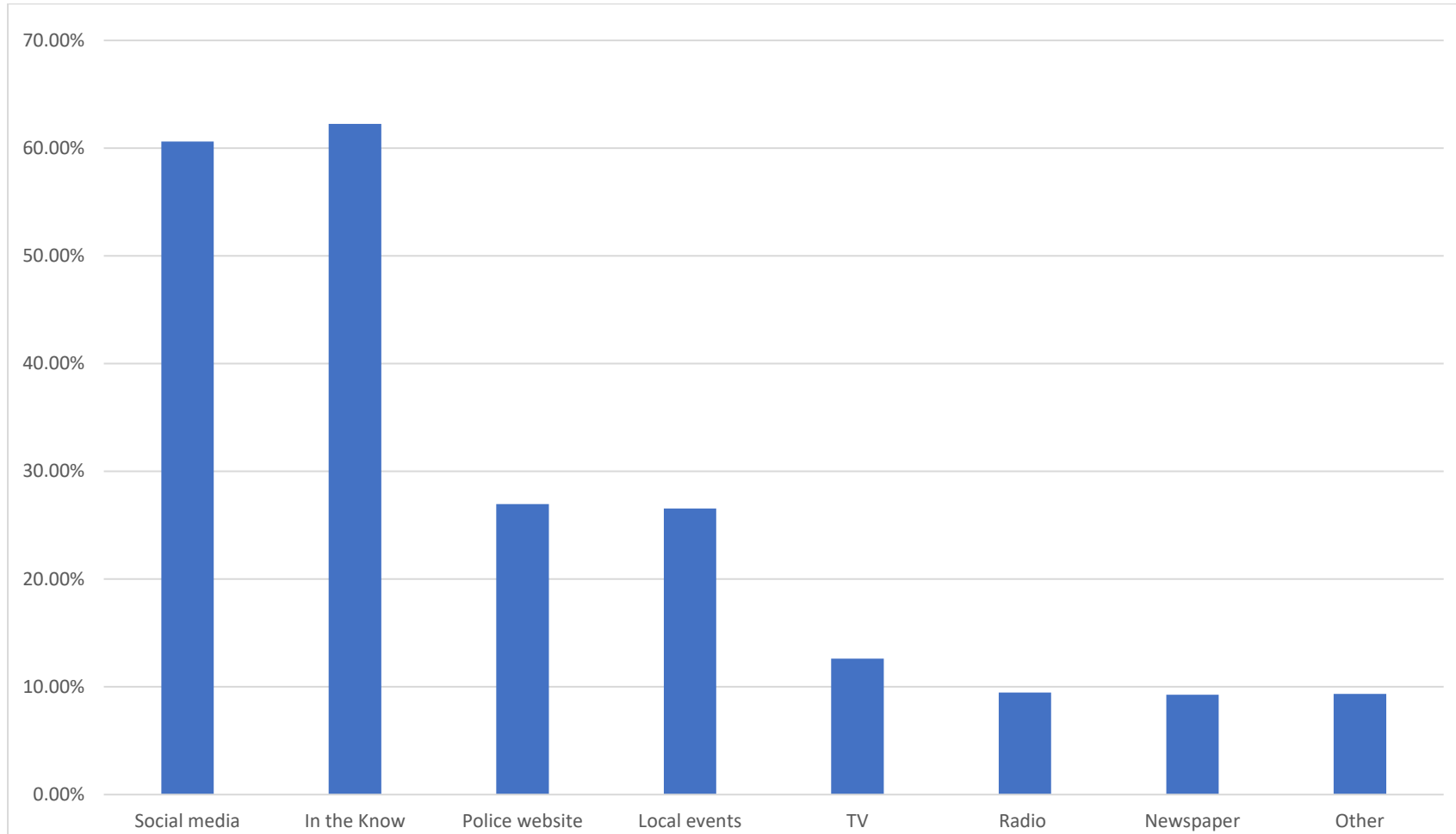
85.62% strongly agree, somewhat agree, or agree on targeting serious and organised crime as an area of focus.

85.73% strongly agree, somewhat agree, or agree on ensuring an effective and efficient policing service for Lancashire.
